Administrator's Report:

November 6 Election with 4,109 votes cast which was 88% of registered voters and 73% of eligible voters. Some statistics: 1,082 absentee ballots of which 868 were in-person absentee; 4 provisional ballots issued and 3 provided their information by the deadline and were counted at the Municipal Board of Canvass; 332 Election Day registrations. The day ran smoothly.

Hosted the Rains to Rivers meeting on October 25. Some topics discussed: new annual reporting provisions by the DNR, looking at hosting a two-day regional training session for storm water and erosion control measures.

Construction has started on the cold storage building; walls are up.

Road Department: brushing in Corydon Park and Corydon West, ditch mowing is largely complete, pot hole patching in various areas, Fall sweeping in urbanized area is complete, paved material storage building lot, and readying equipment for winter.

Received call regarding dirt on road on Old Town Hall Road behind the new Fleet Farm.

Supv. Mueller complimented the Town staff on the ditch mowing.
